# What is the P&C?

- We comprise a community of parents whose children attend Fort Street School, and our shared goal is to foster an optimal learning environment. Our vision is to create a joyful atmosphere that nurtures both academic and personal growth. We aim to provide our children with diverse opportunities for learning, enjoyment, friendship, participation in extracurricular activities, and the building of cherished childhood memories.
- We hope to build a school community that is harmonious and respectful of the more than 50 different nationalities at the school.

### What Do We Do?

- We coordinate enjoyable events within the school community and conduct fundraising
  initiatives to support the school with additional resources and enrichment activities. For
  instance, we've procured musical instruments, laptops, literacy readers, and more through
  our efforts.
- We manage the school canteen ensuring it offers a sustainable selection of healthy menu choices.
- We serve as representatives for parents in discussions with the school executive regarding strategic plans and the redevelopment of the school at Observatory Hill.
- We coordinate class representatives (parents within each class) to act as a central communication hub connecting parents, teachers, the school, and the Parents and Citizens Association (P&C).

# What Can You Do?

The benefit of our modest-sized school, housing over 280 students and representing more than 180 families, lies in fostering a close-knit community where mutual support and familiarity thrive. In contrast to larger institutions where students and families may seem insignificant, our school is characterised by a sense of connectedness. However, the challenge is that our smaller scale necessitates a greater reliance on parental involvement, given the limited pool of parents available for active participation.
